James Hurley '29 starred at quarterback on the Fremont High team for three years before he entered Carroll. Injuries have hampered him so far this year.

Thomas ("Huck") Flynn '29 is an end from Youngstown Rayen. Though light he is a hard man to take out of the play and is speedy on the attack.

William ("Bill") Herzog '27 is Quinn's running mate at tackle. Like Quinn, he is tall, powerful and rangy, and is quick to diagnose a play. He is the ideal type for a tackle. He prepared at Loyola High.

Phillip ("Phil") Wagner '27 came here as a back with a record of two years served on the championship Glenville team. He is a small, speedy type of a player.

Patrick ("Pat") McDonnell '27 is a hard hitting fullback and a tower of strength on the defense. His punts have averaged close to fifty yards this season. Injuries have followed Pat throughout his collegiate term of football but still he sticks to the game. He prepped at St. Ignatius High.

Joseph ("Joe") Hurley '29 starred at quarterback on the Fremont High team for three years before he entered Carroll. Injuries have followed him so far this season.

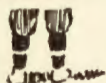

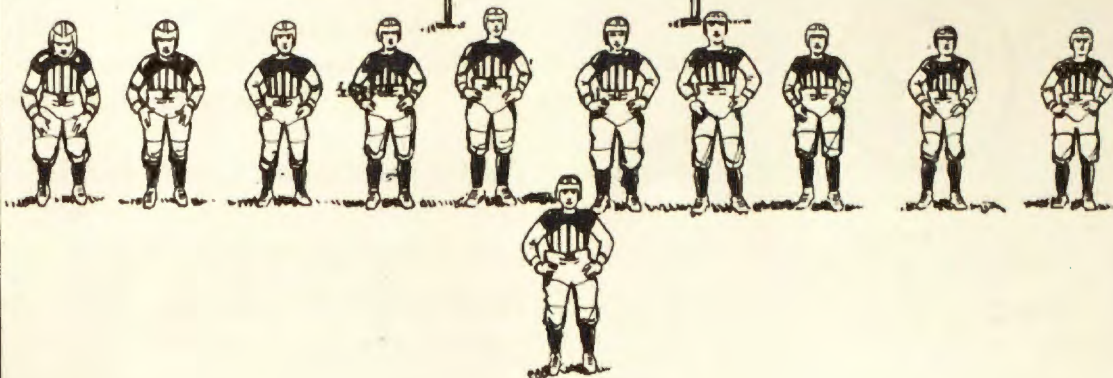

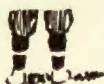
