




HOME OF THE JOHN CARROLL BLUE STREAKS








ntroducing the land's ten best football coaches—looking at them from a lifetime point of view of service on the gridiron. And the list is topped by that Southern gentleman, Mr. Frank Thomas of Alabama.

The next best men in the business are Wallace Wade of Duke and Jock Sutherland of Pittsburgh. These two strategists tied for second place behind Thomas.

In ten years of head coaching, Thomas' teams have won 78 games, lost 13 and tied three. Thomas graduated from Notre Dame in 1923 and in that year and in 1924 he was backfield coach at Georgia.

In 1925 he went to the University of Chattanooga where in four years his teams won 30 and lost 7. In 1929 and 1930 he went back to Georgia at his old job. In 1931 he started at Alabama and won nine and lost one. In 1933 and 1934 he turned out Southeastern Conference championship teams and in his six years with the Crimson Tide, Thomas' teams won 48, lost only six and tied three.

Frank Thomas has had one team in the Rose Bowl. His 1934 team went to Pasadena on New Year's Day of 1935, and whipped Stanford, 29-13, who everyone thought was unbeatable. Here they are, the top ten, according to lifetime records:

(Note: In figuring averages, ties were not counted. Averages are only on a win-lost basis.)

One name that isn't in that list—the "Grand Old Man of Football"—is that of Amos Alonzo Stagg, now coaching at College of the Pacific. Along with Warner, Stagg is one of the truly great veterans of the gridiron. In 47 years of coaching, the majority of which were at Chicago, Stagg's teams have played 445 games and won 273 of them.

Perhaps the most brilliant coaching job in the lot is buried under Gil Dobie's record. In the years 1908 through 1916, Gil coached at the University of Washington and won 58 games, lost none, and tied only three.

Warner's 299 victories gave him the most wins scored by any coach in the land.
