It is the first seal ever to use the name:

t is the first seal ever to use the name: IOHN CARROLL UNIVERSITY.

The seal appeared only once,
on a fund raising brochure of October 1923.
Mr. Tuttle's original plans for the east side campus
were too magnificent to build and never left the drawing board.

In September of 1923 the University changed its name to honor the man who in 1789 became Bishop of Baltimore and so the first Catholic Bishop of the U.S.:

JOHN CARROLL (1735-1815).

A Jesuit until the Suppression in 1773,
he was well-read, grounded in history and theology,
possessed of definite ideas about a liberal arts education,
and open to the new experience of the young Church in the United States.
