## *THE ASCENSION*

From the Cathedral of St. Sophia, Novgorod, ca. 1500.  
Tretyakov Gallery

Against a dark circle representing heaven, the ascended Christ is seated in a position of authority, welcomed and revered by two angels. Two other angels explain the matter to the eleven apostles and Matthias, who was chosen to be an apostle a few days later. The apostles will be sanctified by the Spirit at Pentecost and do not yet have halos. Mary with halo prays in the center. In the background are two trees and stylized mountains.

Icons feature prominently in the liturgy of the Eastern rites. The President of the University is bi-ritual, celebrating the liturgy in the rite of the Byzantine Catholic Church as well as in the Latin rite; hence, his special interest in icons.
