## *THE HOLY TRINITY*

by Andrei Rublev, early 15th century.  
Tretyakov Gallery, Moscow

Andrei Rublev, honored as a saint in the Eastern Church, has in this masterpiece of Russian and world art portrayed the Trinity with utmost economy, his symbolism based on the visit of three angels to Abraham and Sarah at the oak of Mamre (Gen. 18:1). Their intent is redemptive: a sacrificial offering on the table, or rather altar, prefigures the Lamb of God slain for our salvation; the oak tree behind the Christ figure symbolizes his cross. The colors of their cloaks distinguish them as three, the Father to our left. The circular composition, their common transparent beauty, the blue of their garments, their accord, harmony, sympathy and peace manifest the unity of their eternal nature. Here is the Russian people's dream, then as well as now, of civil harmony and peace. The icon invites us to pray before it and to be drawn into the peace and unity of Trinitarian life. The recess in the front of the altar invites us perhaps to enter into the sacrifice as well. A copy of this icon adorns the entrance to Bruening Hall in our School of Business.

Icons feature prominently in the liturgy of the Eastern rites. The president of the University is bi-ritual, celebrating the liturgy in the rite of the Byzantine Catholic Church as well as in the Latin rite; hence, his special interest in icons.

## Biographies of the Commencement Speaker and Honorary Degree Recipients

MOST REV. REMBERT G. WEAKLAND, O.S.B. was born in 1927 at Patton, PA, the son of Basil and Mary Kane Weakland. He entered the Benedictine Order at St. Vincent Archabbey, Latrobe, PA in 1945. Over the following twelve years he studied there, in Italy, France, Germany, and in New York at Columbia University and the Juilliard School of Music. He was ordained a priest (1950) in Subiaco, Italy. His area of specialty and early work was in Church music and liturgy; he is a pianist of concert quality. Weakland served as Archabbot of St. Vincent (1963-1967) and later Abbot Primate of the Benedictine Conference (1967-1977) with responsibility for the Benedictines worldwide, much of his work in both positions being concerned with the renewal of the Order in accordance with the spirit and decrees of Vatican II. In 1968 he presided at the meeting of Monastic Superiors in Bangkok and administered final anointing to the body of Thomas Merton. Since 1977 he has been Archbishop of the Milwaukee Diocese, his episcopal motto "Aequalis Omnibus Caritas" (Equal Love for All). Pastoral programs he initiated there have been closely imitated throughout the United States. He chaired (1981-1986) the committee that drafted for the Bishops of the United States their pastoral letter on Catholic Social Teaching and the U.S. Economy. He is currently the Chairman of the Bishops' Committee for Ecumenical and Interreligious Affairs.

DR. MICHAEL S. PAP was born in Carpatho-Ukraine and studied in Czechoslovakia and Vienna. When the Soviet Union took over his country in 1945, he fled. He earned his doctorate at Heidelberg University in 1948 and, after a time as legal counsel for the International Refugee Organization, came to the U.S.A., becoming a U.S. citizen in 1952. He taught at Notre Dame (1950-1958) and then at John Carroll until his retirement in 1988. He was the founder and director of John Carroll's Institute for Soviet and Eastern European Studies (1961-1987), which was widely influential, especially among educators, and which was a valuable and valued source of information and analysis about Iron Curtain countries. He has served as a board member and director of many ethnic heritage organizations, and was granted a leave of absence (1972-1974) to serve in Mayor Ralph Perk's cabinet as director of the Department of Human Resources and Economic Development for the City of Cleveland. He is the author of books, monographs, and journal articles and a nationally known lecturer on: democracy and totalitarianism, American-Soviet relations, Sino-Soviet relations, dissent in the U.S.S.R. and ethnicity in the U.S.A. He speaks eight languages and has received numerous awards including the Shevchenko Freedom Award, Cleveland's Most Outstanding Naturalized Citizen Award, J.C.U.'s Distinguished Faculty Award, and the U.S. Industrial Council's American Values Award. A longtime Lyndhurst resident, he and his wife Anne have three sons and a daughter.

JAMES S. REID, JR. was born in 1926, the son of James S. and Felice Crowl Reid. He was graduated from Harvard in 1948 and received his J.D. from Harvard Law School three years later. He practiced law first for two years in Detroit and subsequently for three years with Falsgraf, Reidy & Shoup in Cleveland. He joined The Standard Products Company, which was founded by his physician father in 1927 and whose major business is producing specialized rubber and plastic parts for the automobile industry. He began in 1956 as director of industrial relations, and was promoted to division manager of the Fullerton, California plant (1959), executive vice president (1960), president (1962), chairman (1982), and C.E.O. (1989). Under his leadership Standard Products became an international company, one of the Fortune 500, traded on the New York Stock Exchange. He is a director of Society Corporation, a trustee of the Cleveland Musical Arts Association, and since 1968 of John Carroll University; he is a past chairman of the Cuyahoga County Board of Mental Retardation and John Carroll's Board of Trustees. He is active in public service, widely read and widely travelled, and an avid fisherman and tier of flies. He and his wife Donna have three daughters, Sally, Susan and Jeanne.
