

ALUMNI MEDAL AWARDS

Alumni Medals, the highest award of the John Carroll University Alumni Association, are presented annually to alumni and others who have, through the distinguished conduct of their lives, either brought extraordinary credit to the university or contributed conscientious service to the Alumni Association, or both. The recipients of the award this year are:

Robert F. Sly Class of 1942

After he graduated from John Carroll in 1942, Robert Sly became a doctor, specializing in psychiatry. He served as a captain in the Army with the US occupation force in Japan and then returned to his hometown of Dearborn, Michigan, where he established that city's first private psychiatric practice. Young Dr. Sly fought vigorously to ensure that a psychiatric facility would be included in his community's new hospital. When that outcome was in jeopardy, he took his passionate advocacy to Washington and gained the federal funds that enabled Oakwood Hospital to open its doors with a progressive psychiatric unit. Dr. Sly served in that hospital for more than three decades, and became an enduring force for mental health. Dr. Sly has long been a servant of his church, his community, his university and his extended family. He is the kind of man for others who in his 82nd year is the voluntary caregiver for a much younger blind man. In recognition of his service to others, John Carroll is pleased to award Dr. Robert Sly the Alumni Medal.

Rev. Casimir Bukala, S.J. Class of 1954

Casimir Bukala, SJ, a philosophy professor who specializes in existentialism, is a man who has defined himself by the choices he has made in his nearly seven decades. After graduation in 1954 he was a soldier, and then, like Ignatius, he surrendered the sword to become a vicar of Christ. Since he first set foot on that path 44 years ago, Fr. Bukala, universally known as Casey, has created an identity as the quintessential Jesuit, memorable to generations of Carroll students for his jovial, practical and selflessly caring mentoring. Jesuits like to speak of cura personalis, Latin for care of the whole person. Casimir Bukala, SJ, embodies cura personalis. He has also embodied care for the whole university, having been the alumni chaplain, the football team chaplain, the I-Chi chaplain...the list goes on, as well as a recipient of the Distinguished Faculty Award and a man whose life has, for more than half a century, been inextricably interwoven with the fabric of this university. Fr. Casey Bukala, SJ, has done so much for John Carroll for so long that his university is, for so many reasons, deeply pleased to award him the Alumni Association's highest honor, the Alumni Medal.

Gerald J. Schweickert, Ph.D. Class of 1960

It would be tough to top Jerry Schweickert's Carroll credentials: Beaudry Award winner and cum laude graduate; Hall of Fame athlete, three-time all-conference quarterback and the undefeated '59 grid squad's leader, who was also a punter, punt-returner, kicker, kick-returner, defensive back and running back; the coach of five sports and the Blue Streaks' athletic director; founder of the physical education program and a dedicated academic who earned his doctorate and went on to be a long-time professor in the department of Education and Allied Studies. He's been a stalwart of the Alumni Association, an admission counselor and the man who sold tickets, Christmas trees and beer to support his student teams. As a student, coach, professor, alumnus, husband of Beverly, father of four and dedicated Catholic layman, Jerry Schweickert has played more roles with grace, style and competence than most of us could have imagined. For nearly half a century, Gerald J. Schweickert, a member of the class of 1960, has enriched this university community in a myriad of ways. In recognition of that fact, John Carroll is grateful to honor Dr. Schweickert with the Alumni Medal.

Pauline Tarver Class of 1975

For more than two decades, Pauline Tarver has been the "soft-spoken, low-key" woman at the helm of the Cleveland branch of the NAACP. Its elected presidents are the public face of the civil rights organization, but executive director Tarver has supplied the administrative savvy, the political skill and the continuity that resulted, not long ago, in the Cleveland chapter's being named the country's most effective NAACP branch. One former president said in a newspaper story, "I think Pauline knows that it really doesn't matter who the president of the branch is. The president is the most high-profile person in the branch, but the director makes things run." The journalist who wrote that story concluded that Tarver is effective in no small measure because she is a fair-minded listener and a remarkable communicator. He quoted our member of the Class of '75 as saying, "You just have to communicate with everyone no matter what their socioeconomic or cultural background is because we are all fighting a common enemy - racism." That's the other important thing to remember about Ms. Tarver: she may be soft-spoken, but she's a fighter for equality and justice for all, as well as a catalyst for important change. Because she is, John Carroll is pleased to award Pauline Tarver the Alumni Medal.

Carl Walz Class of 1979 MS

With four trips in space, including his current five-month sojourn on the International Space Station, Carl Walz '79 MS is John Carroll's highest flyer and a man who has given us a new measure of how fast a Blue Streak moves. In 12 years as an astronaut, Walz has experienced four space missions, four space walks and four scrubbed attempts to take flight. Throughout the rigors, this former ace test pilot has demonstrated impeccable composure, unfailing good humor and the highest level of competence in his service to science and space exploration. The International Space Station mission, his latest and most demanding test, has given the astronaut new perspective. "I look at this mission much differently after traveling for four years preparing for it," Walz told the Carroll News. "I have a broader vision of the world and the similarities and differences of people in different countries. From orbit you don't see divisions or boundaries. You see continents, and the earth." For allowing us to see through his far-reaching eyes, and for so admirably serving his country, NASA and science, John Carroll is pleased to award Carl Walz the Alumni Association's highest honor, the Alumni Medal.

Biographies of the Commencement Speaker and the Honorary Degree Recipients

A leading scholar on philanthropy, **Leslie Lenkowsky** serves as chief executive officer of the Corporation for National and Community Service. Dr. Lenkowsky was appointed to his current position by President George W. Bush and was confirmed by the U.S. Senate in October 2001. Dr. Lenkowsky is also a former board member of the Corporation, which was created in 1993 to improve local communities through three initiatives: AmeriCorps, Learn and Serve America, and the National Senior Service Corps.

Most recently, Dr. Lenkowsky had been a professor of philanthropic studies and public policy at Indiana University-Purdue University at Indianapolis, as well as a research associate at the Center on Philanthropy at Indiana University since 1997. Prior to joining Indiana University, Dr. Lenkowsky served for seven years as president of Hudson Institute, an internationally renowned public policy research institution headquartered in Indianapolis. Under Dr. Lenkowsky's leadership, Hudson developed an innovative set of programs aimed at providing practical solutions to the nation's most pressing domestic problems, such as crime, welfare dependency, and inadequate educational skills.

Among his other positions, Dr. Lenkowsky has served as president of the Institute for Educational Affairs, deputy director of the United States Information Agency, research fellow at the American Enterprise Institute, adjunct faculty member at Georgetown University, director of the Philanthropy Roundtable, and director of research at the Smith Richardson Foundation. Appointed by President Bill Clinton in 1993 to be one of the founding directors of the Corporation for National and Community Service, Dr. Lenkowsky had previously been named by President George H.W. Bush to the Commission on National and Community Service, He has also served on a number of for-profit and non-profit boards.

A graduate of Franklin and Marshall College, Dr. Lenkowsky received his doctorate from Harvard University. His writing has appeared in such publications as *Commentary, The Weekly Standard, The Wall Street Journal, The Public Interest, The Chronicle of Philanthropy* and the *Indianapolis Business Journal*, and he has spoken frequently to educational and philanthropic groups throughout the United States.

Originally from the North Hills of Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, **Julie Zajac** graduated from North Allegheny High School in 1998. In her senior year, Julie helped her high school track team win a WPIAL title and a state championship. In the fall of 1998, Julie entered John Carroll becoming a member of the class of 2002.

While at John Carroll, Julie was a standout cross-country and track athlete receiving five varsity letters in just three years. Her career culminated in the winter of 2000 when Julie won both the 3,000-meter and 10,000-meter runs at the Ohio Athletic Conference Indoor Track Championships. For her outstanding accomplishment, Julie was presented with the Marcia French Award as the OAC Women's Track Athlete of the Year. During her junior year, Julie went undefeated against Division III competition in the 3,000-meter, 5,000-meter and 10,000-meter events.

Julie excelled academically at John Carroll as well, holding a 3.9 GPA in business finance and making the Dean's List every semester. She was a member of *Alpha Sigma Nu*, the *Jesuit Honor Society*, and a student of the *Boler School of Business*. Julie was fluent in French and studied abroad for a semester in France. In December 2000, Julie was diagnosed with a rare form of cancer. After an eight-month battle with the disease, she passed away in her North Hills home on August 25, 2001 at the age of 21.

Julie is being awarded a posthumous Honorary Bachelor of Science in Business Administration degree.

THE UNIVERSITY MACE

When universities and parliaments about the world gather together in solemn assembly, the way is often led by a mace bearer carrying an ornamental short staff that is the symbol of the authority of the gathering body. The symbol's early predecessor was the Roman fasces, a bundle of rods bound together and carried in front of magistrates; crowds in the streets seeing the fasces would give way to the magistrate's authority. The medieval mace was originally a blunt weapon favored by clergy who were forbidden to use the sword. It also evolved into a symbol of authority; crowds quickly made way for anyone carrying such a symbol.

The design at the top of the University Mace derives from the coats of arms on the university seal, emblems of Ignatius Loyola, founder of the Jesuits. Surmounted by a cross, two bronze wolves on either side of a brass cauldron stand for the Loyolas. The Onaz clan, his maternal side, is signified by fourteen alternating red and gold bands of enamelled copper, set at an angle around the head of the mace. Beneath is the inscription in Latin: John Carroll University 1886. From the cross at the top to the horn button at the base the mace is 46 inches tall; it weighs 100 ounces. The main shaft of the mace is ebony in the form of a fasces of fourteen rods, with a slight tapering at either end. The bindings of the rods, and the head and base of the mace are all silver. A node on the base is engraved with the episcopal seal of Archbishop John Carroll, the first bishop of the United States and the eponym of the university. It depicts the Blessed Virgin with scepter and crown holding the Christ Child; thirteen stars for the thirteen states are around them, the crossed keys of St. Peter beneath, and the inscription in Latin: John, Bishop of Baltimore 1790. Inside the base is a copy of the Articles of Incorporation of the University, its charter, granted by the State of Ohio in 1890 in time to authorize the university's first degrees.

The University Mace was crafted for John Carroll by the late Solve Hallqvist, a well known local silversmith, as his last commission; it was designed by Fr. Peter Fennessy, S.J., former university marshal, and Dr. Roger Welchans, retired professor of Art History. The University Mace was a gift of the Executive Board of the John Carroll Alumni Association; it was given in memory of Fr. Michael J. Lavelle, S.J., twenty-first president of the university (1934-1995).

THE TRADITION OF ACADEMIC COSTUME

One of the more striking aspects of academic ceremonies is the colorful dress of the participants. An understanding of the traditions determining style and color of costumes can enrich one's attendance at such events. The distinctive academic dress has its origin in the universities of the middle ages where cold buildings and tonsured heads made warm gowns and protective hoods a matter of necessity. Individual institutions such as Cambridge and Oxford adopted special rules governing the kind of dress that was to be permitted, and the custom was repeated throughout Europe. It is for this reason that some of the most eyecatching gowns are those mandated by European schools.

In America, the practice has been somewhat less venturesome. Although the custom of wearing distinctive attire had existed since the time of the colonial colleges, present usage seems to date from a conference held at Columbia in 1895. From that meeting came a resolution calling for the regulation by code of what was generally to be worn at academic events. That code, revised in 1932 and again in 1960, makes recommendations as to the pattern, material, color and trimmings to be used on academic gowns.

The bachelor's gown, with long pointed sleeve, is worn closed. The master's gowns, which can be worn open, have a distinct oblong sleeve with an arc cut in the front. Doctors wear the bell shaped sleeved robes which are marked with velvet facing in front and velvet bars on the sleeve. Although these gowns are all ordinarily black, in recent years there have been exceptions made in color.

Hoods for the various degrees differ in length. Bachelors wear three foot hoods; Masters, three and a half; and Doctors, four feet. They are bound by velvet or velveteen in colors which designate the wearer's area of specialization, and they are lined with the colors of the institution granting the degree. At John Carroll, the lining is blue and gold. Many institutions, however, have dispensed entirely with the bachelors' hoods. The colors associated with the more common academic disciplines are: white for Arts and Letters; drab for Business; light blue for Education; purple for Law; dark blue for Philosophy; golden yellow for Science; and scarlet for Theology.

The cap traditionally worn is the black mortar board, although the tam and the Elizabethan will be seen on some of the faculty. The tassel is most often black, Doctors frequently wear gold, and lawyers wear purple.
