Alumni Medals, the highest award of the John Carroll University Alumni Association, are presented annually to alumni and others who have, through the distinguished conduct of their lives, either brought extraordinary credit to the university or contributed conscientious service to the Alumni Association, or both. The recipients of the award this year are:

Richard M. Hamlin, Sr. Class of 1949

The Hamlin name is well-known on the John Carroll University campus through the family's generous gifts to the University that have established Hamlin Hall and The Richard M. & Yvonne F. Hamlin Quadrangle. A 1949 graduate in business administration, Richard "Dick" Hamlin, has served on the John Carroll board for more than 20 years. In 1995, he was named one of the "50 Finest Graduates" of The John M. and Mary Jo Boler School of Business.

Mr. Hamlin is a native of Akron, Ohio, with family ties to that city dating back to the 1830s. He attended Campion Jesuit Preparatory School in Prairie du Chien, Wisconsin, and served in the Navy for two years during World War II before he enrolled at John Carroll. He attributes much of his success to the Jesuits and his Jesuit education during these formative years.

An astute businessman, Mr. Hamlin parlayed a successful 20-year career in residential, commercial and industrial development into a subsequent career specializing in the acquisition, revitalization and expansion of manufacturing companies.

Along the way, he has very generously given back to John Carroll University, The United Way of Summit County, and many other nonprofit organizations.

Mr. Hamlin epitomizes the service and leadership aspects of our mission at John Carroll. Over the years, he has repeatedly opened his home to host University guests and events. He also is a valued member of the University's Board of Directors and member of the Board's Finance Committee, a prior member of the Board's Properties and Advancement Committees, and a former chair of his Reunion Class Gift Committee.

For his extraordinary dedication, benevolence and service to the University and to his communities, the John Carroll Alumni Association gratefully awards Richard M. Hamlin our 2008 Alumni Medal.

## Jack T. Hearns Class of 1961, 1964G

Jack Hearns virtually grew up at John Carroll University. His father directed the university band for more than 40 years and his mother taught English at John Carroll for more than 20. The now-retired nationally known educator started his career as a high school band director and music teacher. Wanting to have more impact on children's lives, he became a high school guidance counselor, then dean of students, assistant principal, principal and, finally, superintendent of schools in Warrensville Heights, Ohio.

He credits, in no small measure, Father Joseph Owens, S.J., at John Carroll for his success. Dr. Hearns, who earned his bachelor's in social services and a master of arts degree at John Carroll, was a student in five of Father Owens' classes. The Jesuit also was his master's advisor and career mentor.

Dr. Hearns has written articles about and lectured nationally on education issues. He has also written articles for John Carroll magazine, and served as a long-time class columnist for the magazine, which earned him the 2007 Silver Quill Award. He has taught classes and guest-lectured at Carroll, served as co-chair of his two most-recent class reunions, and won the John Carroll Alumni Educators Award (among other awards).

When he retired in 1993 as superintendent, the tireless retiree launched a real estate appraisal firm. He still finds time to regularly attend Carroll events, deliver copies of The Carroll News to older alumni, and is an active member of the Entrepreneurs Association, where he sponsors students for membership in the Collegiate Entrepreneurs' Organization.

For his life-long dedication to students, fellow alumni, and to the University, the John Carroll Alumni Association is proud to award Jack T. Hearns our Alumni Medal.

## Michael L. Hardy Class of 1969

As partner-in-charge of the Cleveland office of Thompson Hine LLP, one of the largest and most-respected law firms in the country, Michael Hardy leads a group of more than 150 attorneys, and personally specializes in environmental law. Entrepreneurs' Organization - and through prior service on the University's Board of Regents, Alumni Association Board, and as a Class Agent on reunion committees.

For his past and present involvement in and dedication to the University, his outstanding professional leadership, and for his long-time commitment to Greater Cleveland, the John Carroll Alumni Association is pleased to award Michael L. Hardy our 2008 Alumni Medal.

Sr. Nancy J. Conway, CSJ Class of 1971

Sr. Nancy Conway is a member of the Congregation of Saint Joseph headquartered in Cleveland, Ohio. She is among a group of dedicated women who have brought together seven formerly independent congregations of Sisters of Saint Joseph from seven states and Japan to form the new Congregation of Saint Joseph. The membership of the new congregation, of which Sr. Nancy serves as President of the Leadership Team, includes 850 sisters, 550 associates and 350 employees. The congregation sponsors more than 40 organizations/institutions, including schools, social service agencies, shelters and adult literacy programs. It also co-sponsors one of the largest Catholic healthcare systems in the U.S., with hospitals, acute care facilities, nursing homes and home health programs in 15 states.

Sr. Nancy has also served as a partner in the company, Organizational Leadership. In that capacity, she has worked as an organizational consultant with over 130 not-for-profit agencies, hospitals and religious groups.

Sr. Nancy says she attended John Carroll University at a very significant time in its history, "when it was very active in facing social issues, like the war in Vietnam. My recollection is that the Jesuits provided a lot of leadership to help us understand our response in faith to social issues of our time."

As a member of the first class of women admitted to John Carroll, Sr. Nancy recalls that "the majority of the female students in my class were nuns," and adds, "I think that was a huge disappointment to the male students!"

For her lifetime of commitment to, and leadership of, the Congregation of Saint Joseph and their good work, it is with both pride and humility that the John Carroll Alumni Association awards Sr. Nancy J. Conway, CSJ, our 2008 Alumni Medal.

## Barbara O. Brown Class of 1982

Barbara Brown sought a Jesuit college education, because she appreciated how the Jesuits "incorporated faith in everything they taught."

She received her bachelor's degree in communications from John Carroll and is grateful to her professors for showing her how to "practically apply" her education. As a student intern at the Greater Cleveland Growth Association, Ms. Brown witnessed the power of communications and the positive effect it could have on economic development. At the same time, the Chicago native fell in love with Cleveland, which she saw as a place where you could "make a contribution and see some of the contribution you make."

To that end, and after several successful years in corporate communications, marketing, and advertising, Ms. Brown co-founded BrownFlynn Communications in 1996 with Margaret Flynn. BrownFlynn has evolved into an award-winning corporate responsibility and sustainability consulting and communications firm, focused on helping companies examine their impact on society. As chief client officer, Ms. Brown counsels and assists

clients in tailoring their community involvement to their core competencies, ethical values and business objectives.

Similarly, Ms. Brown and Ms. Flynn emphasize community involvement at BrownFlynn and ask associates to be involved in their respective communities. Every five years, the firm undertakes a project to benefit an organization in need. The BrownFlynn Book Club, for instance, put 500 new curriculum-based books in the neediest schools in the Cleveland Metropolitan School District.

Ms. Brown remains actively involved at John Carroll as past vice chair and current member of the Entrepreneurs Association, where she sponsors students for membership in the Collegiate Entrepreneurs' Organization.

## Biographies of the Commencement Speaker and Honorary Degree Recipient

**Dr. Patrick Rombalski** joined John Carroll University as dean of students in 1997 and was appointed vice president for student affairs in August 2002. Throughout his 28 years in Jesuit education, Dr. Rombalski's vocational and personal inspiration has come from the educational vision of the Jesuits. It is this inspiration that enabled Dr. Rombalski to make a lasting impact on the John Carroll community.

During his tenure at John Carroll, Dr. Rombalski enhanced student programs, fostered community among undergraduate and graduate students, developed co-curricular and volunteer-service opportunities, and improved services and outreach to underrepresented student populations. Described by colleagues as a dynamic leader and community builder with an extensive and varied background in student affairs, Dr. Rombalski's work is a testimony to the vision, mission and core values that only a Jesuit education can provide.

Dr. Rombalski also serves as executive director of Rostro de Cristo, a Catholic program whose mission is to provide spiritual and educational opportunities for young people from the United States who participate in immersion experiences in Duran, Ecuador. This program has instilled in thousands of young people around the nation, a concern for the poor and marginalized. Dr. Rombalski's work with Rostro de Cristo and in higher education provides a model for all students to discover how they can use their greatest talents to serve those with the greatest needs.

A 1986 graduate of Marquette University, Dr. Rombalski holds a master's degree in student personnel from Iowa State University, and a doctorate in higher education management from the University of Pennsylvania. His doctoral dissertation, John Carroll University: A Review and Assessment of Its Jesuit and Catholic Mission explored the influence and impact of our Catholic and Jesuit heritage. Dr. Rombalski has lectured at Jesuit Association of Student Personnel Administrators (JASPA) conferences, been published in student affairs publications, and has taught several undergraduate classes. In June, Dr. Rombalski will leave John Carroll to become vice president for Student Affairs at Boston College.

**Dr. Martin J. Schreiber, Jr.** '72 is chair of the Department of Nephrology and Hypertension in the Glickman Urological and Kidney Institute at Cleveland Clinic. Dr. Schreiber received his medical degree from Wake Forest University. He did his internship and residency at the Cleveland Clinic, and subsequently held fellowships at the Clinic and also at Renal Unit and Pathology Department at Massachusetts General Hospital, Harvard Medical School in Boston. In 1982, he was appointed to the Cleveland Clinic staff. His areas of medical specialization are: hypertension, diabetic renal disease, home dialysis, and acute kidney injury.

Dr. Schreiber was honored as the Kidney Foundation's Man of the Year for 2007. The citation references "his outstanding leadership and commitment to serving the renal healthcare community."

"Every year, the Kidney Foundation honors someone who embraces our mission of serving individuals and families suffering from kidney failure. Marty was an obvious choice because his dedication and selfless commitment to the community are evident every time you speak to him," said Alex Fuerst, Kidney Foundation chair.

Dr. Schreiber and his wife, Margaret, '84 are the parents of three children, and the family resides in University Heights. Their son, Martin, is a Jesuit studying at the Jesuit School of Theology in Berkeley, California, and will be ordained in June 2009.

As a student at John Carroll University, Dr. Schreiber was in Student Union, a Father Bukala Student, and a member of Alpha Epsilon Delta.

#### THE UNIVERSITY MACE

When universities and parliaments about the world gather together in solemn assembly, the way is often led by a mace bearer carrying an ornamental short staff that is the symbol of the authority of the gathering body. The symbol's early predecessor was the Roman fasces, a bundle of rods bound together and carried in front of magistrates; crowds in the streets seeing the fasces would give way to the magistrate's authority. The medieval mace was originally a blunt weapon favored by clergy who were forbidden to use the sword. It also evolved into a symbol of authority; crowds quickly made way for anyone carrying such a symbol.

The design at the top of the University Mace derives from the coats of arms on the university seal, emblems of Ignatius Loyola, founder of the Jesuits. Surmounted by a cross, two bronze wolves on either side of a brass cauldron stand for the Loyolas. The Onaz clan, his maternal side, is signified by fourteen alternating red and gold bands of enamelled copper, set at an angle around the head of the mace. Beneath is the inscription in Latin: John Carroll University 1886. From the cross at the top to the horn button at the base the mace is 46 inches tall; it weighs 100 ounces. The main shaft of the mace is ebony in the form of a fasces of fourteen rods, with a slight tapering at either end. The bindings of the rods, and the head and base of the mace are all silver. A node on the base is engraved with the episcopal seal of Archbishop John Carroll, the first bishop of the United States and the eponym of the university. It depicts the Blessed Virgin with scepter and crown holding the Christ Child; thirteen stars for the thirteen states are around them, the crossed keys of St. Peter beneath, and the inscription in Latin: John, Bishop of Baltimore 1790. Inside the base is a copy of the Articles of Incorporation of the University, its charter, granted by the State of Ohio in 1890 in time to authorize the university's first degrees.

The University Mace was crafted for John Carroll by the late Solve Hallqvist, a well known local silversmith, as his last commission; it was designed by Fr. Peter Fennessy, S.J., former university marshal, and Dr. Roger Welchans, retired professor of Art History. The University Mace was a gift of the Executive Board of the John Carroll Alumni Association; it was given in memory of Fr. Michael J. Lavelle, S.J., twenty-first president of the university (1934-1995).

#### THE TRADITION OF ACADEMIC COSTUME

One of the more striking aspects of academic ceremonies is the colorful dress of the participants. An understanding of the traditions determining style and color of costumes can enrich one's attendance at such events. The distinctive academic dress has its origin in the universities of the Middle Ages where cold buildings and tonsured heads made warm gowns and protective hoods a matter of necessity. Individual institutions such as Cambridge and Oxford adopted special rules governing the kind of dress that was to be permitted, and the custom was repeated throughout Europe. It is for this reason that some of the most eye-catching gowns are those mandated by European schools.

In America, the practice has been somewhat less venturesome. Although the custom of wearing distinctive attire had existed since the time of the colonial colleges, present usage seems to date from a conference held at Columbia in 1895. From that meeting came a resolution calling for the regulation by code of what was generally to be worn at academic events. That code, revised in 1932 and again in 1960, makes recommendations as to the pattern, material, color and trimmings to be used on academic gowns.

The bachelor's gown, with long pointed sleeve, is worn closed. The master's gowns, which can be worn open, have a distinct oblong sleeve with an arc cut in the front. Doctors wear the bell shaped sleeved robes which are marked with velvet facing in front and velvet bars on the sleeve. Although these gowns are all ordinarily black, in recent years there have been exceptions made in color.

Hoods for the various degrees differ in length. Bachelors wear three foot hoods; Masters, three and a half; and Doctors, four feet. They are bound by velvet or velveteen in colors which designate the wearer's area of specialization, and they are lined with the colors of the institution granting the degree. At John Carroll, the lining is blue and gold. Many institutions, however, have dispensed entirely with the bachelors' hoods. The colors associated with the more common academic disciplines are: white for Arts and Letters; drab for Business; light blue for Education; purple for Law; dark blue for Philosophy; golden yellow for Science; and scarlet for Theology.

The cap traditionally worn is the black mortar board, although the tam and the Elizabethan will be seen on some of the faculty. The tassel is most often black, Doctors frequently wear gold, and lawyers wear purple.
