Donald R. Coburn, M.D.
Class of 1943

Donald Coburn '43 was known as a "doctor's doctor" during his 40 years of practicing medicine. After accelerating through John Carroll, Don completed an efficient medical education at the Jesuit's St. Louis University in 1945; practiced as a doctor in the Army for the next four years, and then gathered additional medical knowledge at the University of Pennsylvania. There was a residency at the Cleveland Clinic and a stint at Mercy Hospital in Canton, after which the doctor locked into a long, productive run as a thoracic surgeon at Euclid General Hospital. Dr. Coburn was a consummately dedicated physician whose sterling reputation endures 20 years after his retirement. One exotic dimension of this steady and marvelously productive workaholic is that, every day, for close to 30 years he rose before dawn; rode his ancient bicycle 12 miles to the hospital; rode back to the Heights at day's end — much of the time after dark; and did it again for thousands upon thousands of next days. The bike has been upgraded and if you look carefully you can still see Don, in all weather, peddling to the supermarket or on other errands to which Elaine, the mother of their seven children has assigned him. Don has passed on his passion for biking to those seven children, five of whom graduated from the neighborhood university, as he has passed on his passion for Cape Cod, and for being a servant leader in one's community, parish, family, university. Dr. Don has been a profoundly valuable presence in all those contexts. For his exemplary service to so many for so long, John Carroll is pleased to present Dr. Donald Coburn with the Alumni Medal.

Salvatore R. Felice
Class of 1957

Fortunately for the university there would be a myriad of candidates for the following hypothetical distinction, but if there should be an effort to select *the* most loving and devoted son of John Carroll, the contest would be a fraud were the name of Salvatore R. Felice '57 not given deep consideration. Paul Kantz, Jr.
Class of 1963

John Breen '56, the former chair of the university board and an Alumni Medal winner in 2005, said on the occasion of the retirement of Paul Kantz, Jr., in 1999: "Of all the development people with whom I've worked at various organizations, Paul Kantz was the most effective." It would not be difficult to gather a large squadron of corporate, civic and educational leaders who would attest to the truth of that assertion. Paul Kantz was a rock at his alma mater for a long time. He was a valuable staff member for a dozen years before he became vice president for development in 1981, but when he moved into that office, he became a pillar. He led John Carroll through four capital campaigns, each of which had a satisfying outcome. He led the team that raised over \$100 million overall during his watch, and, thus, became one of the creators of contemporary John Carroll. He was a boss who expected and exhibited attention to detail as well as a determination to see that tasks for the university were done well. He was also a deeply compassionate leader who daily illuminated what it takes to be a 'man for others.' After Paul and Kay, the mother of their four sons, migrated to Florida following the vice president's retirement, Paul's leadership and compassion found a vehicle in the management of a large Central Florida hunger center, a challenging mission that continues. Paul Kantz has been a memorable exemplar of the Jesuit commitment to service. For all he is and all he has given to his alma mater and the world, John Carroll is pleased to present him with the Alumni Medal.

Molly G. Robinson
Class of 1975

He who nominated Molly Robinson '75 for the honor she is about to receive, said the phrase most characteristic of this consummate volunteer is: "Yes, what can I do." That "Yes" has been a long-running surrender to the service of others. Molly was a leader of the Rochester, N.Y., alumni after she graduated. She went on to organize presidential receptions, college nights, and service activities in Baltimore, and then, when her young family found a home in Detroit, she was the stalwart of the Detroit alumni. Rev. Joseph H. Callahan

Joe Callahan '79 was a chemistry major at John Carroll who found a vocation to the priesthood after he graduated. Six years after ordination, Joe Callahan found a home, El Salvador, the Land of the Saviour. He joined the Cleveland Mission Team, which for more than 40 years has labored and suffered and loved (always) in the impoverished, war-torn, exhilarating and inspiring Central American nation. To see the team at work is to understand the Gospel with new eyes. To walk with Padre José Callahan among the people he loves is to become opened to the power of the shepherd as he cares for his flock. The other men and women honored tonight offer inventories of generous activities. Joe Callahan does one thing; he lives the Gospel, especially the Beatitudes, among the people of El Salvador. To see that one thing as it plays out in time is, inescapably, to be humbled. Honorary degree citations written by George Bilgere, Department of English

Named a "First Lady of Catholic Education" by Today's Catholic Teacher, Sister Mary Peter Traviss, OP, PhD, will receive a doctor of humane letters honorary degree from John Carroll's as the university's 2006 commencement speaker. A native of California, Sister Mary Peter entered the Dominican Sisters of Mission San Jose and pronounced her final vows in 1954. Sister Mary Peter holds a PhD from Stanford University and has pursued additional graduate studies at both Harvard and Oxford universities.

Sister Mary Peter has served as a teacher, principal and the director of education for her community. She has directed workshops for faculties, parish catechists, and diocesan teachers' institutes across the country. Sister Mary Peter's work has taken her to Europe, Asia, Australia and South Africa. She joined the faculty of the Institute for Catholic Educational Leadership (ICEL) at the University of San Francisco in 1984; she became the director of that program in 1989. In that position, she guided numerous students to the completion of their doctoral studies.

Intent on bringing scholarly research to a broader audience, she organized a forum at the National Catholic Educational Association's annual convention at which doctoral students could share new learnings. Seventeen years later, this forum has become a standard event at the convention. A founding member of the journal, *Catholic Education: A Journal of Inquiry and Practice*, Sister still serves as a reviewer.

From 1976-1984, Sister Mary Peter served as adjunct professor of education in the Institute for Catholic Educational Leadership. Upon her retirement from the University of San Francisco in 2005, NCEA presented her with the Elizabeth Ann Seton Award. Sister Mary Peter began a new role in 2006 as president of Queen of the Holy Rosary College, Mission San Jose in California; and she is now professor emerita at the University of San Francisco.

THE UNIVERSITY MACE

When universities and parliaments about the world gather together in solemn assembly, the way is often led by a mace bearer carrying an ornamental short staff that is the symbol of the authority of the gathering body. The symbol's early predecessor was the Roman *fasces*, a bundle of rods bound together and carried in front of magistrates; crowds in the streets seeing the *fasces* would give way to the magistrate's authority. The medieval mace was originally a blunt weapon favored by clergy who were forbidden to use the sword. It also evolved into a symbol of authority; crowds quickly made way for anyone carrying such a symbol.

The design at the top of the University Mace derives from the coats of arms on the university seal, emblems of Ignatius Loyola, founder of the Jesuits. Surmounted by a cross, two bronze wolves on either side of a brass cauldron stand for the Loyolas. The Onaz clan, his maternal side, is signified by fourteen alternating red and gold bands of enamelled copper, set at an angle around the head of the mace. Beneath is the inscription in Latin: John Carroll University 1886. From the cross at the top to the horn button at the base the mace is 46 inches tall; it weighs 100 ounces. The main shaft of the mace is ebony in the form of a *fasces* of fourteen rods, with a slight tapering at either end. The bindings of the rods, and the head and base of the mace are all silver. A node on the base is engraved with the episcopal seal of Archbishop John Carroll, the first bishop of the United States and the eponym of the university. It depicts the Blessed Virgin with scepter and crown holding the Christ Child; thirteen stars for the thirteen states are around them, the crossed keys of St. Peter beneath, and the inscription in Latin: John, Bishop of Baltimore 1790. Inside the base is a copy of the Articles of Incorporation of the University, its charter, granted by the State of Ohio in 1890 in time to authorize the university's first degrees.

The University Mace was crafted for John Carroll by the late Solve Hallqvist, a well known local silversmith, as his last commission; it was designed by Fr. Peter Fennessy, S.J., former university marshal, and Dr. Roger Welchans, retired professor of Art History. The University Mace was a gift of the Executive Board of the John Carroll Alumni Association; it was given in memory of Fr. Michael J. Lavelle, S.J., twenty-first president of the university (1934-1995).

THE TRADITION OF ACADEMIC COSTUME

One of the more striking aspects of academic ceremonies is the colorful dress of the participants. An understanding of the traditions determining style and color of costumes can enrich one's attendance at such events. The distinctive academic dress has its origin in the universities of the Middle Ages where cold buildings and tonsured heads made warm gowns and protective hoods a matter of necessity. Individual institutions such as Cambridge and Oxford adopted special rules governing the kind of dress that was to be permitted, and the custom was repeated throughout Europe. It is for this reason that some of the most eye-catching gowns are those mandated by European schools.

In America, the practice has been somewhat less venturesome. Although the custom of wearing distinctive attire had existed since the time of the colonial colleges, present usage seems to date from a conference held at Columbia in 1895. From that meeting came a resolution calling for the regulation by code of what was generally to be worn at academic events. That code, revised in 1932 and again in 1960, makes recommendations as to the pattern, material, color and trimmings to be used on academic gowns.

The bachelor's gown, with long pointed sleeve, is worn closed. The master's gowns, which can be worn open, have a distinct oblong sleeve with an arc cut in the front. Doctors wear the bell shaped sleeved robes which are marked with velvet facing in front and velvet bars on the sleeve. Although these gowns are all ordinarily black, in recent years there have been exceptions made in color.

Hoods for the various degrees differ in length. Bachelors wear three foot hoods; Masters, three and a half; and Doctors, four feet. They are bound by velvet or velveteen in colors which designate the wearer's area of specialization, and they are lined with the colors of the institution granting the degree. At John Carroll, the lining is blue and gold. Many institutions, however, have dispensed entirely with the bachelors' hoods. The colors associated with the more common academic disciplines are: white for Arts and Letters; drab for Business; light blue for Education; purple for Law; dark blue for Philosophy; golden yellow for Science; and scarlet for Theology.

The cap traditionally worn is the black mortar board, although the tam and the Elizabethan will be seen on some of the faculty. The tassel is most often black, Doctors frequently wear gold, and lawyers wear purple.
